2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition
challenging the order dated 16.01.2025 bearing Memo No. 05
(Annexure-P/3 to the writ petition) issued by respondent No. 6 /
the Secretary, Block Selection Unit-cum-Block Development
Officer, Tharthari Block, District-Nalanda, whereby, the



petitioner’s services as Block Teacher at Middle School, Naradi in Tharthari Block, District- Nalanda has been terminated.
