ORAL ORDER

2 29-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Lakhaura PS Case No. 19 of 2025 instituted for the offences
under Sections 30(a), 32 and 41 of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 50 litres
of country made liquor was recovered from Boat situated at
Sikrahana River and there is also recovery of one motorcycle
bearing Regd No. BR05BH-0347.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got



no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is submitted that recovery is made from a boat situated at bank of Sikrahana river which is not belonging to the petitioner. It is further submitted that the seized motorcycle also does not belong to the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 19.03.2025 and has got two criminal antecedents in which he is on bail. There is no compliance of Section 103 of B.N.S.S.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Lakhaura PS Case No. 19 of 2025.
