petitioner and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 303(2), 352, 351(1) and 3(5) of the B.N.S..

3. As per prosecution case, all the F.I.R. named accused persons, including this petitioner, assaulted husband of informant and also snatched *Mangalsutra* of the informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. As a matter of fact, both parties are own *Gotiya* and due to admitted land dispute, this false and concocted case has been lodged. Allegation of assault is general



and omnibus and no specific accusation of overt act has been alleged against this petitioner. Petitioner claims clean antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, general and omnibus nature of accusation and clean antecedents of the petitioner, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is allowed.

7. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-1st, Hilsa, District-Nalanda in connection with Chandi P.S. Case No. 241 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S..
