ORAL ORDER

2 30-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Special Excise Case No. 1270/2025 arising out of Paliganj P.S. Case No. 223 of 2025 dated 12.05.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 23.250 litres of illicit foreign liquor and Rs. 7,41,000/- from the house of the co-accused, Chhote @ Nitesh Kumar. Total 1164.210 litres of illicit foreign liquor was also recovered from the dilapidated house of the co-accused, Chhote @ Nitesh Kumar.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of



the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Chhote @ Nitesh Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery rather the recovery has been made from the house of the co-accused person. The petitioner has three criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 17.06.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Danapur, Patna in connection with Special Excise Case No. 1270/2025 arising out of Paliganj P.S. Case No. 223 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
