4 31-10-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
A.P.P. for the State, and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Simri (Hata O.P.) P.S. Case No. 137 of 2021, registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 324,
325, 307, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation against the petitioner is that he
caused injury to the victim.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
there is a case and counter case and that the occurrence has
taken place on account of a land dispute. It is further submitted
that the petitioner is a student of Intermediate and is in custody
since 11.06.2025.



5. Learned counsel for the informant has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and has produced medical records from B.H.U., submitting that the petitioner caused grievous injury to the victim by means of a sharp-edged weapon.

6. Considering the submissions of the parties and the materials on record, it appears that the petitioner is accused of assaulting the victim with a sharp-edged weapon, resulting in grievous injury.

7. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this application stands dismissed.

8. However, if the trial is delayed by the prosecution, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail.
