2 03-11-2025 Following are the reliefs sought in the present writ application:-

“I. For issuance of an appropriate writ(s) in the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondents to stop the illegal construction doing by the antisocial elements over the land of Kabristan situated on Gairmazarua Mallik land bearing Khata No. 696 and 2373 and Khatiyani No. 522 and



534.

II. For issuance of any direction(s) directing the respondents to take legal action against those persons who are constructing illegal construction over the Kabristan land.

III. Any other relief(s) to which the petitioner is found entitled to, in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. It appears that petitioner has raised a personal grievance in present writ petition. Such individual grievance cannot be entertained upon in a PIL.

3. If so advised, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach the competent local authorities for the redressal of his grievance in accordance with law.

4. With the aforesaid direction, the writ petition stands disposed of.

5. Pending Application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
