2 31-07-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the pe-
titioner and learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case regis-
tered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 29.325 litres illicit foreign
liquor was recovered from the house of this petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner sub-
mits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated
in this case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of this petitioner and he is in no way
connected with the aforesaid recovery. Petitioner claims clean
antecedents.

5. On the other hand, learned APP appearing for the



State submits that petitioner is not entitled to the privilege of anticipatory bail in view of decision of the Full Bench of this Hon'ble Court rendered in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar* reported in *2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)*.

6. Considering the nature of accusation and aforesaid decision of this Hon'ble Court, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to this petitioner is rejected.
