3 21-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case,
registered for offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2),
351(2), 352, 109, 85 of the B.N.S., 2023 and Section 3, 4 of the
Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. The informant, who is wife of petitioner, alleges
that her husband used to torture and beat her for dowry. She
further apprehends that she might be killed by him and
thereafter, on 13.03.2025, her husband (petitioner) and Sautan
demanded ten lakh rupees, as dowry, and objection, both of
them brutally assaulted her. During course of treatment, the
informant died.

4. Considering the nature of accusation and the fact
that petitioner is husband of the informant (deceased) and there



is specific allegation that he alongwith other co-accused demanded dowry and due to non-fulfillment of the same, they assaulted her (informant), as a result of which, she died during course of treatment, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner is rejected.
