ORAL ORDER

2 01-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Areraj P.S. Case No. 56 of 2025 registered under Sections 274, 275 of B.N.S. and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case in short, is that, total 110.57 litres of liquor was recovered near Pokhara.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is submitted that recovery is made from an open place, which is accessible to one and all. The petitioner has got three criminal antecedents.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the



prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner and submits that the petitioner bears three criminal antecedents. Hence, the petitioner does not deserve the privilege of anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and criminal antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7. The prayer is *rejected*. However, the petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below and pray for regular bail. If any such application is filed, the Court below shall consider and dispose of the same on its own merit without being prejudiced by this order.
