2. Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Rail
P.S. Ara Case No. 75 of 2025, in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 117(2), 126(2), 303(2),
103(1) and 3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023.

3. As per prosecution story, informant alleged that on
27.04.2025, his brother went to catch train. Meanwhile, some
unknown persons assaulted him brutally and snatched his gold
chain. During course of treatment, he died.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. F.I.R. was registered against unknown. Name of petitioner
transpired during the course of investigation. There is delay of
17 days in lodging the F.I.R. The petitioner bears clean



antecedent and he is in custody since 20.05.2025. Charge-sheet has been submitted.

5. Learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant opposes the prayer for bail and submits that during course of investigation in the CCTV, this petitioner was seen during occurrence.

6. Considering the nature of accusation and period of custody of the petitioner, his prayer for regular bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, mentioned above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M., Railway, Ara (Bhojpur) in Rail P.S. Ara Case No. 75 of 2025.
