2 19-09-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 30(a), 30(c) and 30(d) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 25 litres illicit country
made liquor was recovered from an open place.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence.
No incriminating article has been recovered from conscious
possession of this petitioner and has been made an accused in
this case merely on suspicion. The alleged illicit liquor has been
recovered from an open place, which is accessible to one and
all. Charge-sheet has already been submitted and petitioner is in



custody since 21.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of accusation and period of custody, the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge, Excise-02, Nawada in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 196 of 2025.
