A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per F.I.R., total 600 liters of country-made liquor was recovered from five seized motorcycles.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is neither owner nor driver of any of the seized motorcycle and has been made accused only on suspicion. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances,



let the above named petitioner, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise, Patna City (Patna) in connection with Didarganj P.S. Case No. 324 of 2024, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023.
