3 08-01-2025 The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for a direction upon the police officer to register a criminal case against the accused persons.

2. The State-Respondents have filed a counter affidavit. It appears from para-11 of the counter affidavit that police have already registered Rupaspur P.S. Case No.826 of 2024 dated 09.12.2024 under Section 304A of the I.P.C.
