ORAL ORDER

2 05-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with G.R. No. 852 of 2025 arising out of Sakri P.S. Case No. 109 of 2025 dated 23.06.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 274, 275 of B.N.S. & Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 129 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the Car.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner no.1 (Laxman Sah @



Laxman Kumar Sah) is the owner of the said vehicle as stated in para-15 of the bail petition. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioners are in custody since 23.06.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioners above-named, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Madhubani in connection with G.R. No. 852 of 2025 arising out of Sakri P.S. Case No. 109 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
