2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Baniyapur P.S. Case No. 60 of 2023 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. This is the second attempt for bail of the petitioner
as earlier such prayer was rejected by order dated 10.01.2024 in
Cr. Misc. No. 75376 of 2023.

4. The petitioner is accused of looting a motorcycle,
Rs. 59,020/- and a Tab.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly
submits that the trial has started and one witness has been
examined.

6. In view of the fact that the trial has started, this



application is dismissed.

7. The Superintendent of Police, Saran is directed to ensure the presence of the witnesses on the date fixed in the trial so that the trial is not delayed and the accused do not get the benefit of the delay.
