2 01-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sadar
PS Case No. 166 of 2025 instituted for the offences under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 180.500
litres of liquor was recovered from Bushes.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got
no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is submitted
that recovery is made from an open place, which is accessible to
one and all. It is further submitted that apprehended co-accused



Mr. Shravan Kumar disclosed the name of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 19.06.2025 and has got one criminal antecedent in which he is on bail. There is no compliance of Section 103 of B.N.S.S. Similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted regular bail by this Court vide orders dated 01.07.2025 and 03.07.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. Nos. 40763 of 2025 and 41487 of 2025 respectively.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Sadar PS Case No. 166 of 2025.
