A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Udawantnagar P.S. Case No. 101 of 2024 dated 13.03.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 176 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the bank of Banas river.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in this case on mere suspicion. Nothing has been recovered from the



conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 28.06.2025. The co-accused person has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 16.06.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 36389 of 2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Bhojpur in connection with Udawantnagar P.S. Case No. 101 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
