4 09-10-2025 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.
Chandra Bhushan Prasad, learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 316(2),
318(1) and 3(5) of the BNS.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
Investigating Officer of the case is present in the Court and
submits that notice under Section 35 BNSS has been issued to
the petitioner yesterday, i.e., 08.10.2025.

petitioner submits fairly submits that petitioner has received the
notice, as such, for the present, petitioner does not have any
apprehension of arrest, hence, seeks permission to withdraw the
