1. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 1377 of 2024, which has stood dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 15.07.2024.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that since the counsel for the petitioner was engaged in another Court, he could not appear when the case was called out for hearing, hence, the aforesaid writ petition was dismissed for want of prosecution, thus a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid writ petition be restored to its original file.
