ORAL ORDER

2 13-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Kako P.S. Case No. 33/2025 dated 13.02.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a), 32, 36 and 41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 329.625 litres of illicit foreign liquor was recovered from the car.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the



confessional statement of the co-accused, Kanhaiya Kumar. As per para. 10 of the bail petition, the petitioner is not the owner of the said car. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has two antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 16.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Jehanabad in connection with Kako P.S. Case No. 33/2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
