Advocate for the petitioner that the petitioner is aggrieved

against an order passed in Misc. Case No.1433M/2024 under

Section 163 of the B.N.S.S.

2. The dispute regarding alleged nuisance and
apprehended danger arose in connection with ownership and
possession of a piece of land, only because of such dispute, an
order under Section 163 of the B.N.S.S. cannot be challenged by
filing a writ petition alleging that the dispute involves land
matter.

3. Considering such circumstances, this Court is of the



view that the instant writ petition is not maintainable. However, petitioner is permitted to file appropriate writ petition challenging the order passed under Section 163 of the B.N.S.S. by filing Cr.W.J.C.

4. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
