ORAL ORDER

16 30-07-2025 This contempt petition has been filed alleging

violation of order dated 01.10.2010 passed in CWJC No. 13334

of 2010, wherein, interim order was passed as hereunder:-

*“Till further orders of this Court, all
orders of Universities shifting the date of
appointment/shifting the date of promotions, the
consequence whereof is demand of refund of excess*



payment or reversion, shall remain in abeyance.

Petitioners would be treated as they were for all purposes before the date of impugned orders.”

3. The writ petition has been dismissed for non prosecution by an order dated 05.12.2023.

4. No case of contempt has been made out since the writ petition itself stands dismissed and the same accordingly stands closed and disposed off.
