3 24-03-2025 It is submitted by the learned Advocate for the petitioner that after institution of the instant writ petition, police has already registered F.I.R. and the investigation of this case is going on. Therefore, the first prayer of the petitioner being satisfied, no order is required to be passed in this regard.

2. It is also submitted by the learned Advocate for the petitioner that police authority may be directed to investigate the case properly. I am afraid, a writ court cannot pass any such directions because it is the domain of the learned Magistrate to make necessary order if the investigation is found to be



perfunctory or not properly conducted, as the second prayer of the petitioner cannot be entertained by the writ court, the said prayer is rejected.

3. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is thus, disposed of.
