ORAL ORDER

3 12-11-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State. Perused the case diary.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sarai
P.S. Case No. 79 of 2023 instituted for the offence under
Sections 363, 366A & 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, informant alleged that on
16.03.2023 at about 5:00 AM, her daughter was taken away by
Yogendra Ram (petitioner) with the help of his brother-in-law
Gariban Ram and sister Pinki Devi.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 17.04.2025. Petitioner
bears no criminal antecedent, as per disclosure made in
paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.



5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that victim has refused for her medical examination. Referring to the statement of the victim recorded under section 183 of the BNSS, it is submitted that victim has clearly stated that she was never kidnapped and there is no allegation of sexual assault against the petitioner. Charge sheet has already been submitted in this case.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner, there being no allegation against the petitioner in the statement of the victim recorded u/S 183 of the BNSS, 2023 and charge sheet being submitted, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Sarai P.S. Case No. 79 of 2023, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.



(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
