ORAL ORDER

2 08-09-2025 Heard Mr. Sheo Nandan Prasad, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Navin Kumar Pandey, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with Safiyasarai P.S. Case No. 121 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 281, 125(a) (b), 109 and 132 of the B.N.S.

3. As per the allegation made in the FIR, the petitioner had allegedly tried to ran over a police personnel from his Scorpio vehicle bearing Registration No. BR10PA9313.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. He is having forty percent benchmark disability in both his legs and, as such, the allegation



as alleged in the FIR is false and fabricated. He further submitted that the Scorpio Vehicle bearing Registration No. BR10PA9313 is registered in the name of the petitioner and is not a stolen vehicle, which was found to have collided with the fencing of the road. Petitioner has clean antecedent. On these grounds, petitioner seeks to be released on pre-arrest bail.

5. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail.

6. Considering the rival submissions made on behalf of the parties, as well as, the allegation made in the FIR, learned District Court is directed to obtain a report from the District Transport Officer concerned in respect of Scorpio Vehicle bearing Registration No. BR10PA9313 and in case, on the basis of Chassis Number, Engine Number and Registration Number, it is found that the said vehicle is registered in the name of the petitioner and is not a stolen one, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned District Court within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Munger, in connection with Safiyasarai P.S. Case No. 121 of 2024, subject



to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

7. The learned District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail application. If any other case is pending against the petitioner as what has been stated in paragraph no. 3, this order will lose its force automatically.
