A.P.P. for the State.

2. Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Parnadabar P. S. Case No. 3/2025 in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 41 of the Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 150 liter county made
liquor was recovered from the seized motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no
incriminating material has been recovered from conscious
possession of the petitioner and he is no way connected with the
aforesaid recovery. Petitioner is neither driver nor owner of the
vehicle in question. Petitioner is in custody since 08.07.2025.
Charge-sheet has already been submitted.



5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposes the bail application.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and period of custody, the bail application is allowed. Let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court-I, Nawada in connection with Parnadabar P. S. Case No. 3 of 2025.
