of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No.4210 of 2020, which has

stood dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated

10.10.2022.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has

submitted that the aforesaid case could not be marked in the

daily cause list on 10.10.2022, resulting in the counsel being

unable to attend the case when the case was called out for

hearing, leading to dismissal of the aforesaid petition for non-



prosecution, hence, a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid petition be restored to its original file.
