ORAL ORDER

2 30-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 368 of 2025 dated 28.05.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 30(a), 32(1), 32(3), 41(1), 41(2) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 360 litres of illicit country made liquor was recovered from the Bolero pickup vehicle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is the co-passenger of the said vehicle.



The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 28.05.2025. The co-accused person has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 28.07.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 49201 of 2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 368 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
