6 12-09-2025 The learned counsel for the opposite party-B.N. Mandal University submits that in case the petitioner submits the requisite documents along with a detailed claim petition before the Committee constituted in pursuance to the directions issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court, vide order dated 11.07.2019, passed in Contempt (C) No.1188 of 2018 within a period of four weeks from today, which may also be filed through his representative since he is bedridden, the same would definitely be considered



in accordance with law and a final decision would be taken with regard to payment of the admissible amount of arrears of salary and pension, if any, within a period of three months, thereafter. It is directed, accordingly.
