2. The present petition has been preferred for the

compensation amounting to Rs.40,000/- to
the petitioner for his house which was taken
for construction of Maharajganj-Mashrak
Rail line situated in Khesra No. 3803, Plot

Learned State Counsel has taken this Court to paragraph-10 of the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the Collector, Saran at Chapra to submit that the order of the learned Sub-Judge-II cum Special Court in (LAR) in LAR Case No. 42 of 2010 has already been complied and enhanced compensation amount has been paid vide cheque no. 022524 dated 06.02.2014.
