ORAL ORDER

2 20-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Alamganj P.S. Case No. 551 of 2025, instituted for the offences
punishable under Sections 316(2), 318(4) and 3(5) of the
Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that a four-
wheeler with three passengers picked up the informant and his
nephew on their way to Hasanpur, Samastipur. It is further
alleged that near Jalla Road, Alamganj, the passengers allegedly
snatched Rs. 9,000/- and the informant's mobile, then tricked
them by handing over a purse for safekeeping before fleeing.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the



present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has transpired in this case on the basis of confessional statement made by owner of the car in question and the same has got no evidentiary value. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not the owner of the car in question rather he was found driving the vehicle. The petitioner is in custody since 22.05.2025 and has got no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail ***after framing of charge, if not already framed*** on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Alamganj P.S. Case No. 551 of 2025, subject to the following conditions:



(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
