2 10-09-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

petitioners and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case

registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2),

115(2), 329(4), 118(1), 74, 303(2), 352 and 3(5) of the B.N.S..

3. As per prosecution case, Petitioner No. 1 assaulted

informant with sword and Petitioner No. 2 assaulted daughter-

in-law of informant with iron rod.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on

behalf of the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and



have committed no offence. As a matter of fact, both parties are *Gotiyas* and due to petty family feud, this false and concocted case has been lodged. Doctor has opined the injuries, sustained by the injured, as simple in nature. It is further submitted that the present F.I.R. has been lodged after inordinate delay of five days and there is no plausible explanation for the same. Petitioners claim clean antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, relationship between the parties, nature of injuries sustained by the injured and clean antecedents of the petitioners, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is allowed.

7. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioners be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Danapur, Patna in connection with Maner P.S. Case
