3 26-11-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 186 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 109(1), 192, 191(2), 117(2) and 3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

3. The allegation is of assaulting the informant by means of lathi and rod inflicting injury on his head and also taking Rs.30,000/- from his pocket.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have committed no offence as alleged and they have falsely been implicated in the case. The petitioners have clean antecedent.



5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioners, **learned District Court is directed to verify the injuries attributable to the petitioners and if the injuries attributable to the petitioners, sustained by the informant are found to be simple in nature**, then the petitioners, above named, be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned District Court where the case is pending in connection with Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 186 of 2025, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C / 482(2) BNSS.

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners and if it is found that the petitioners are involved in some other cases as what has been stated in Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its force.

8. The bail application stands disposed of.
