2 22-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case instituted
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. There is recovery of 4.5 litres illicit Indian made
foreign liquor from the house of co-accused Akash Kumar, who
disclosed that the petitioner used to bring illicit liquor.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused.
Petitioner was neither present on the spot at the time of alleged
occurrence nor any incriminating material has been recovered
from conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has no
concern with the seized illicit liquor. The alleged recovery has



been made from the house of co-accused Akash Kumar. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he undertakes to cooperate in the investigation and the trial.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court concerned in connection with Maner P.S. Case No.66 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
