ORAL ORDER

4 18-11-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 10 of 2024 dated 06.01.2024 registered for the offences punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, two unknown miscreants ridden on motorcycle are alleged to have come and surrounded the informant and his staff, thereafter they snatched Rs. 1,50,000/- from the pockets of the informant on the point of pistol.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in this case in the self confessional statement recorded before police in connection with Harsidhi, East Champaran P.S. Case No. 429 of 2024. No T.I.P. has been conducted by the prosecution. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence. The petitioner has twenty-two criminal antecedents in which 15 criminal cases were lodged in the same year 2024 as stated in para 3 of the supplementary affidavit filed on behalf of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 29.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 10 of 2024, with a condition:-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date,



failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner are liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
