2 09-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case instituted
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. There is recovery of 3 litres country made liquor from a
place situated near Government Animal Hospital beside the
house of co-accused Garbhu Rajwansi, who was apprehended
on the spot. The local *chaukidar* has disclosed the name of
petitioner, who is alleged to have fled away from the spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case on the basis of disclosure made by local *chaukidar*. Except
disclosure statement, there is nothing against the petitioner.
Nothing has been recovered from conscious possession of the



petitioner. Petitioner has no concern with the seized illicit liquor. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he undertakes to cooperate in the investigation and the trial.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise, Court -1, Nawada in connection with Hisua P.S. Case No.355 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
