2 11-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners seek regular bail in a case registered under Sections 30(a) and 37 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 127.5 litres of illicit liquor was recovered from the hut situated near bamboo clump.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. Further submission is that petitioners have neither the owners nor the caretakers of the hut in question from where the illicit liquor has been recovered.



Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. Petitioners are not involved in the selling or purchasing of illicit liquor. Petitioners have clean antecedent and there is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the evidence. Petitioners are in custody since 24.07.2025 and they undertake to cooperate in the trial.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioners.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned District and Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge, Excise-II, Madhepura in connection with Madhepura Excise P.S. Case No. 189 of 2025.
