2. This is second anticipatory bail application on behalf of the petitioner. Earlier, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner was rejected on merit vide order dated 22.09.2023 passed in *Cr. Misc. No. 53313 of 2023*.

3. This application does not reveal any new facts and circumstances for reconsideration of prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. In view of the recent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***G.R. Ananda Babu Vs. State of Tamil Nadu and Anr.*** reported in ***2021 SCC OnLine SC 176***, this second anticipatory bail on behalf of the



petitioner is not maintainable.

4. This application is, accordingly, dismissed.
