2 22-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with N.H. Bangra P.S. Case No.62 of 2025 instituted under
Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, there is recovery of
8.625 litre illicit liquor from the tanki of toilet beside the house
of co-accused Chandan Kumar and petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case only on the basis of suspicion. He further submits that the
alleged recovery of liquor has been made from the abandoned
toilet which was used commonly and petitioner has no concern



with the said place. Learned counsel submits that petitioner has no concern with the alleged seized liquor and no incriminating article has been recovered from her conscious possession. He further submits that petitioner is a lady, having clean antecedent and she undertakes to cooperate in the investigation and trial.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, in the event of arrest or surrender before the concerned Court within six weeks from today, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Excise Court-I, Samastipur in connection with N.H. Bangra P.S. Case No.62 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
