2. The present writ petition has been preferred for directing the respondent authority to investigate the complaint of the petitioner made under F.I.R. No.- 262/2024, Dighwara Police Station dated 24.07.2024 registered for the offence u/s- 126(2), 115, 118(1), 74, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. and further



directing the Senior Superintendent Police, Patna to apprehend the accused namely (i) Mainuddin Ansari (ii) Salman Ansari (iii) Kalim Ansari (iv) Zainul Miyan (v) Nawab Miyan (vi) Taufiq Ansari (vii) Salman Ansari (viii) Qasim Ansari (ix) Hashim Miyan (x) Kalim Miyan (xi) Zainul Miyan (xii) Tasleem Miyan (xiii) Mainuddin (xiv) Hashim Miyan (xv) Tony Khatoon (xvi) Nagma Khatoon (xvii) Motijan Bibi (xviii) Lalbabu Miyan (xix) Ramzan.

This application is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Magistrate concerned for redressal of his grievances by way of filing a petition in accordance with law and in view of the law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Sakiri Vasu v.
