ORAL ORDER

- 4 05-06-2025 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned APP
for the State and learned counsel for the opposite party no.2.
2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of
anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest in connection with
Complaint Case no. 205 of 2023, registered under sections 498A,
341, 323, 406, 379 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code and sections 3
and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.
3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner was married
to the complainant in the year 2021, however soon thereafter, the
accused persons started torturing her for non-fulfillment of the
demand of dowry leading to filing of the instant case.
4. By order dated 22.3.2025, the matter was referred to



the Mediation Centre of the Patna High Court for amicable settlement of dispute between the parties.

5. A report of the Mediator dated 25.4.2025 has been received stating therein that the dispute between the parties has been resolved and the terms of settlement arrived at has been attached with the report.

6. The terms of settlement attached with the report of the Mediator is reproduced herein below for ready reference :-

An agreement made on 23.04.2025 at the High Court Patna Mediation Centre, between,
Vishal Kumar, Son of Sanjay Kumar @ Sanjay Paswan, Resident of Village-Bahiro, P.S.-Ara Nawada, District-Bhojpur.
--- (First party)/ Petitioner.

And

Gudiya Devi, D/o Manjee Ram, Resident of Village-Madariya, P.S.-Charpokhari, District-Bhojpur.
--- (Second party)/Opposite party No.2.

Both the parties appeared in the Mediation Proceeding along with their Advocates and ready to resolve the dispute through the Mediation Proceeding on the following terms and conditions:-

1. That after great persuasion both the parties agreed to live separately and for this the petitioner offered to pay Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) for full and final settlement and Opposite party No.2 accepted the offer and gave her consent to finally compromise this case i.e. Bhojpur Complaint Case No.205 of 2021 pending in the Learned Court below. Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) through cash to the opposite party No.2.
2. That the petitioner has agreed to give the followings items to the opposite party No.2:-
 1. पलंग-1, 2.बक्सा-2, 3. कुर्सी-टेबूल-1, 4. तोशक रजाई-1, 5. तकिया-2, छिपा, लोटा, गिलास कस्तरी-छेका में तिलक एवं 6-तीन सेट वर्तन-स्टील, पीतल।
3. This settlement shall be full and final settlement and no any claim in future against each other.
4. That Opposite Party No.2 also agreed to withdraw the case and she does not want to proceed with the all Civil/Criminal cases.
5. That both the parties will never claim for any grievances either matrimonial disputes and share of property of each other.

6. That both the parties file petition of 13 (b) of Hindu Marriage Act before the Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Ara after one month from today and on the day of filing of petition of 13 (b). Petitioner will give of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) to Gudiya Devi @ Gudiya Kumari.
7. That after the filing of on the next day of filing of petition U/s 13 (B) of Hindu Marriage Act, the Opposite Party No.2 will go to her matrimonial house i.e. the petitioner house and take all the utensils which is given in the agreement and will receive the utensils of the petitioner.
8. That the above contents of the agreement have been read over and explained to us in Hindi which are have fully understood and accepted there upon.
9. That in the above terms and conditions a settlement has been arrived at between the parties and both have signed in presence of their learned counsels, who have also put their signature on this agreement.

satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate,
Bhojpur, Ara.
