2. The present writ petition has been filed for :

*i) For issuance of a writ, in the nature
of a writ of certiorari, setting aside and
quashing of the entire proceeding of pending
case before the court of Deputy Collector, Land*



Reforms, Patna Sadar, being Bihar Land Dispute Case No. 145 of 2014-15 brought by the private respondent, the respondent no.-6, under section 4 of Bihar Land Dispute resolution Act 2009 read with rule 3 of Bihar Land Dispute Resolution Rules 2010. The Court of Deputy Collector, Land Reforms lacks jurisdiction over the case mentioned herein above.

ii) For issuance of a writ in the nature of a writ of mandamus directing and commanding the respondents to behave well within the prescribed units. limits of law.

iii) For issuance of any other writ(s)/ order(s) as your lordship may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of this case.
