2 23-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered
under Sections 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, there is recovery of 14
litres of illicit liquor from the motorcycle of the petitioner. Two
persons apprehended on the spot namely, Raju Kumar and
Surendra Ram.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case being the owner of the seized vehicle. Further submission
is that on the alleged date of occurrence, the vehicle in question
was taken by the neighbour of the petitioner, namely, Raju
Kumar for purchasing medicine since his mother was seriously



ill and without knowledge and consent of the petitioner, his vehicle was being used for transportation of illicit liquor. It is submitted that petitioner has no concern with the seized illicit liquor and nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he undertakes to cooperate in the investigation and trial.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court concerned in connection with Excise Case No. 91 of 2025, Bikramganj P.S. Case No. 33 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023.
