ORAL ORDER

2 18-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Medni Chowki P.S. Case No. 84 of 2025 dated 13.06.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 317(2) of the B.N.S. and u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 36 litres of illicit country made liquor was recovered from the motorcycle which was being ridden by the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is the owner of the said vehicle but he has no concern with the alleged recovery. The other co-accused person has already been granted bail by this court *vide* order dated 06.08.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 53684 of 2025. The petitioner has four criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 14.06.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Lakhisarai in connection with Medni Chowki P.S. Case No. 84 of 2025, with the following condition:

(I) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.



7. The application stands allowed.
