ORAL ORDER

8 13-10-2025 The present Civil Miscellaneous Application has been filed by the petitioner for a direction to the learned Sub Judge II, Patna to dispose of Title Partition Suit No. 122 of 1997 at the earliest which is pending in the Court of learned Sub Judge II, Patna since last 26 years and till date even the issues have not been framed.
