9      08-05-2025                      In the Paragraph No. 6 of the counter affidavit filed  
by the Respondent Nos. 3 to 5, it is stated as under:-

*“6. That it would not be out of place to mention here that the petitioner submitted her application for obtaining the PDS license on compassionate ground and accordingly thereafter her claim was considered by the Licensing Authority i.e. SDO, Sadar, Gaya and accordingly SDO, Sadar, Gaya directed to District Education Officer, Gaya vide letter No. 1464 dated 27.12.2019 to get the said certificate verified to which the DEO, Gaya vide letter no. 1805 dated 13.07.2022 intimated that there is no such*



*school namely Middle School Khaira under Konch Block and as such it was conclusively established that the certificate produced by the petitioner was forged.”*

2. Having regard to the above, this Court does not find any merit in the present writ petition which warrants any interference and the same is accordingly dismissed.
