2. This contempt petition has been filed alleging
violation of the order dated 10.08.2018 passed in C.W.J.C.



No. 14580 of 2018, wherein, respondent no. 6 of the writ petition – the District Programme Officer, (Establishment), Samastipur has been directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioners and pass necessary order(s) within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of copy of the order.

3. Opposite Party No. 6 – the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Samastipur, has filed a show cause, wherein, in paragraph no. 7, it has been stated that in compliance of order dated 10.08.2018 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 14580 of 2018, Opposite Party No. 6 has passed a reasoned order vide Memo No. 2696 dated 12.08.2021 rejecting the petitioners' prayer for promotion in view of departmental order contained in Memo No. 5066 dated 11.04.2019.

4. A copy of the reasoned order dated 12.08.2021 vide Memo No. 2696 passed by the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Samastipur has also been enclosed as Annexure-B to the show cause.

5. In view of the above, I find that the order dated 10.08.2018 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 14580 of 2018 has been



complied with by the Opposite Parties.

6. Accordingly, the contempt petition stands closed and disposed of.
