A.P.P for the State and learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Jhajha P.S.

Case No. 583 of 2023, registered for offence punishable under
Sections 467, 468, 471, 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per F.I.R., the allegation against petitioner is
that he misappropriated FD receipts and cheques from South
Bihar Gramin Bank and cheated bank customers by fraudulently
withdrawing money from their bank accounts and also of taking
cash in the name of fixed deposit, but did not deposit the same
in the bank.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. At the relevant time, petitioner was working as temporary *Safai Karmi* in the bank and informant wanted to remove him from job and therefore, this false and concocted case has been lodged. Petitioner was working in the bank since March, 2016, but there was no complaint against him. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. However, learned counsel for the bank vehemently opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that petitioner is named in the F.I.R. with specific allegation that he, while functioning as *Safai Karmi*, misappropriated FD receipts and cheques of the bank and also fraudulently withdrew money of bank customers.

6. Considering the nature of accusation, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner is rejected.
