2 28-11-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 30(c), 32(iii), 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 65 liters illicit liquor was recovered from the hut of petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that no incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and he is no way connected with the aforesaid recovery. Petitioner has been made accused only on suspicion.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State submits that huge quantity of illicit liquor was recovered from the hut of the petitioner and he has got six criminal antecedents of similar



nature. He further submits that petitioner is not entitled to the privilege of anticipatory bail in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar* reported in **2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)**.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, anticipatory bail application of the petitioner is rejected.
