ORAL ORDER

2 17-09-2025 Heard Mr. Vijay Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Anil Kumar, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 98 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109(1), 303(2), 352 and 3(5) of the BNS.

3. Allegation is of assaulting the *Gotni* of the informant by means of axe on her head and also the informant and her family members with an intention to kill.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the case. There is case and counter case between the parties. The parties are agnates.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioner no.2 Ravi Kumar to be specific, I am not inclined to enlarge him on pre-arrest bail.

7. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioner nos. 1, 3 and 4 to be general and omnibus, they are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-I, Siwan in connection with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 98 of 2025, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C / 482(2) BNSS.

8. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners and if it is found that the petitioners are involved in some other cases as what has been stated in Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its force.



9. The bail application stands disposed of.
